MEDICAL EXAMINATION

1. REQUIREMENTS:

29 CFR 1910.134(e) specifies the minimum requirements for medical evaluation that employers must implement to determine the employee's ability to use a respirator.

2. HEALTH AND PHYSICAL CONDITIONS:

A physician shall determine the health and physical conditions that are pertinent for an employee's ability to work while wearing a respirator. The following factors may be pertinent for this determination:

- Emphysema
- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
- Bronchial asthma
- X-Ray evidence of pneumoconiosis
- Evidence of reduced pulmonary function
- Coronary artery disease or cerebral blood vessel disease
- Severe or progressive hypertension
- Epilepsy, grand mal, or petit mal
- Anemia, pernicious
- Diabetes, insipidus, or mellitus
- Punctured eardrum
- Pneumomediastinum
- Communication of the sinus through upper jaw to oral cavity
- Breathing difficulty when wearing a respirator
- Claustrophobia or anxiety when wearing a respirator
